Available to clubs and individual swimmers

INDIVIDUAL SWIMMERS WHO ARE MEMBERS OF LINCOLNSHIRE AFFILIATED CLUBS

Any swimmer on the BS World Class Podium (including water polo, disability, diving, and synchro) can claim up to £200 per year for travel and hotel expenses incurred in competing in top class competitions or training events and are not otherwise reimbursed.

Any swimmer on the BS World Class Podium Potential (including water polo, disability, diving, and synchro) can claim up to £200 per year for travel and hotel expenses incurred in competing in top class competitions or training events and are not otherwise reimbursed.

AFFILIATED SWIM21 CLUBS

Grants towards teaching and coaching courses

UKCC level one coaches up to £50.00

UKCC level two coaches up to £100.00

UKCC level one teachers up to £75.00

UKCC level two teachers up to £125.00

UKCC level three coaches up to £150.00

Each application will be considered by the Hon County treasurer and reimbursed if the criteria are met. Payments will be reported at each County Exec meeting on an up-dated figure paid. This will be reviewed if necessary, for any part of the financial year remaining.

Room hire charges for official's courses and examinations can be claimed.

Special club events – up to £250 can be claimed for various club activities such as swim camps away from usual training venues, training days when guest speakers/coaches attend. Each submission will be considered individually.

Safeguarding and protecting children workshops

Funding support to clubs of £20 per person towards IOS/ASA face to face safeguarding workshops and £10 per person towards the cost of the SCUUK online safeguarding renewal. Proof of payment and copies of certificate of attendance along with ASA numbers and position held to be submitted with request.
