

## Conditions for East Midlands Masters Records

### General

1. The Region shall maintain a list of Regional Masters swimming records. Incorporating the 18-24 age group and all masters groups from 25-29 and upwards.
2. Records shall be maintained for all short course (25m) and long course (50m) individual events as swum in the Swim England Masters Championships and for such other events as shall be determined from time to time.
3. A swimmer's age shall be his or her age on 31 December in the year of the competition. Swimmers must be 18 years of age or over on the day of setting a record.

### Swimmers claiming records shall

5. Have swum under the name of an East Midland Regional club when recording the time concerned or have been nominated through an East Midland Regional club for a representative team such as one of the Regions five Counties.
6. Have made the performance concerned at an event which is electronically timed and the time shown on the British Masters Ranking system.
7. Submit the claim form to the given email within 28 days of the event including proof of the time set and club representation, a web link to the results sheet is sufficient for this. It will not normally be necessary to submit proof of a time set in the Regional Masters Championships.
8. Provide proof of age on request.
