## **NEW** – Event Accreditation Update

Please be aware that the event accreditation system available via member options. is now checking that barred list check is in place as well as the date this expires. Due to this, members may see an in date DBS but this element showing as a fail: should this occur the DBS was not with barred list check. An example of this is below. If this is the case, you will need a new DBS for the appropriate role.

## **NEW** – Everyone Active Sporting Champions – Athlete Funding

The Everyone Active Sporting Champions funding is now open.

From regional competitors to Paralympians and Olympians, they support athletes of all ages and at all levels. As a minimum, the applicant must either:

- Be a nationally ranked athlete
- Be a member of a regional squad with regional results in the previous two years or have represented at regional level in the previous two years
- Or have finished in the top eight at regionals or equivalent competition in the previous two years

## **NEW** – Club Constitution of a Charitable Incorporated Organisation

Charitable Incorporated Organisations (CIOs) are a relatively new legal structure available for charities or charitable groups that wish to be incorporated. It is designed to offer the protection of limited liability status (normally only afforded by a charitable company) but without the burden of dual regulation associated with a charitable company. CIOs are only regulated by the Charity Commission and they manage the application process.

## Regional Long Course Championship accreditations

There is one accreditation for the full long course Championships, most Regions are now using the accreditation system so please be mindful when ordering so you have the right accreditation for our Championships. The accreditations will be available up to and during the Championships but we would encourage everyone who may be attending checks that all their elements are 'green/pass' so any issues can be resolved early.

## World Aquatics Swimming Rules update

As you may or may not be aware World Aquatics (FINA) rules for the period 2023-2025 were published on 3 January 2023.

It was subsequently agreed by the three Home Nations that these rules would be implemented for swimming and open water across the board with effect from Friday 10<sup>th</sup> March 2023.

New CPDs, which form a mandatory part of the officials relicensing process, are being rolled out to educate officials on the changes. The swimming CPD will be delivered face to face/remotely – the plan regarding this will be circulated when available. Details of the open water CPD will be emailed to all open water officials in due course.

## New 2023 Swim England Handbook published.

Including new club complaints process and the revised disciplinary process.

The 2023 Swim England Handbook and the updated WavePower publication are now available. Please read through for updates including revised regulations on safeguarding and welfare, the new club complaints process and the revised disciplinary process.

A number of drop-in sessions have been arranged to enable clubs to raise any questions regarding these updates. Sessions are open to club, county and regional committee / board members, coaches and welfare
