## Good Governance Chairs and Welfare Officers workshops

We have been made aware that from November 2023 it will be a mandatory requirement for all Club Chairs and Welfare Officers to have attended their relevant Good Governance Workshop. These free workshops are run for all roles every month. For more details please go to our workshops page. The requirement for Masters clubs will only be for a Chair's attendance, not welfare officers.

# Previously shared information



## Important change to safeguarding training requirements.

From 1st of January 2024, the Swim England Safeguarding CPD will be the only acceptable training for those working or volunteering within our clubs, counties and regions.

All current approved training will be valid until it expires.

Training is a mandatory requirement for coaches, teachers and all volunteer roles who require a DBS and must be renewed every 3 years.

This update also addresses a gap in the national governing bodies training policy to cover 16 and 17 year olds who are in a 'Position of Trust'. From the start of next year, Swim England Safeguarding Training will be required for those in this age group that are in coaching or teaching roles and are delivering a Swim England recognised activity.

### Supervision ratios

Swim England have published a <u>new policy</u> regarding the supervision ratios for clubs within aquatics.

Previously, the guidance was in Wavepower and within Swim England's Team Manager training, however, as part of our commitment to providing a safe environment for all members, a new policy is being introduced. ## Good governance reminder

We have recently been made aware of issues within clubs relating to volunteers not being members, and also regarding AGMs being run incorrectly.

A reminder to all clubs:

- Any and all persons helping within the club (in a paid or voluntary role) must be a club and hence Swim England member.
- At club AGMs or SGMs the only persons allowed to vote or be heard are "paid up members who have reached their 16th birthday" – please note parents do not have a right to speak or vote on behalf of their children unless they are paid members in their own right. Some clubs have implemented the following clause in their constitution to address this: [For every family with one or more children under the age of 18 a minimum of one parent or guardian must be a member of the Club and all relevant fees paid]
- Please could we encourage and remind clubs to consult their constitution (particularly sections 9-12 for unincorporated clubs) prior to their AGM in order to ensure it is run correctly.
