A gentle reminder to all April SwimMark and SwimMark health check clubs that the deadline for all elements to be both submitted and <u>approved</u> by is **Monday the 17th of April.** If you need any assistance, please email helen.bickerstaff@swimming.org Failure to have elements 5, 6, 7, 10 and 13 approved by this deadline may result in a temporary or permanent suspension for your club; meaning your club and members would not be insured to train or compete.

This annual report has been a great opportunity to reflect on the achievements and progress of last year.

DBS and Safeguarding

Unfortunately, we are still finding many club members who do not hold an in date or valid DBS check, or safeguarding training. Please can we ask all clubs to be proactive and vigilant in ensuring all relevant checks are in place. Anyone without necessary DBS and Safeguarding must not be on poolside, or working with children until training and/or checks are complete.

- As per <u>WavePower</u> guidance: DBS is needed for those aged 16 or over, in a role
 working with children. The level of DBS check is dependent on the role, for instance a
 coach requires a higher level DBS (Enhanced disclosure with barred list check) than
 a poolside helper so this should be taken into consideration.
- Safeguarding is required for those 18 and over. Safeguarding training should be from an approved provider, as per <u>WavePower guidance</u>. <u>Please click here for upcoming</u> <u>courses</u>

Transgender and non-binary competition policy

Swim England's updated transgender and non-binary competition policy has inclusion and fairness at its very heart.

Swim England believes the creation of open and female categories is the best way to achieve this.

These categories are designated as:

- Female athletes with a birth sex of female
- Open athletes with a birth sex of male, trans or non-binary competitors and any competitor not eligible for the female category

The policy refers only to Swim England competition (including those organised by our member Regions, Counties, Clubs and affiliated organisations) and will be implemented on 1 September 2023.
