3 dates have been identified for delivery of the Open Water Technical Officials Course:

- Saturday 29th April
- Sunday 7th May
- Saturday 3rd June

These dates are primarily aimed at new Open Water officials, they can either be completely new to officiating or hold an officiating qualification in another discipline. However, if you know of existing Level 1 officials who wish to upskill please ask them to complete the survey so that we can establish demand for a session just for this purpose.

The cost of the course is £20 for new officials, which will include a practical logbook and their first licence upon qualification, or £15 if they already hold a licence in another discipline. Transgender and non-binary competition policy

Swim England's updated transgender and non-binary competition policy has inclusion and fairness at its very heart.

Swim England believes the creation of open and female categories is the best way to achieve this.

These categories are designated as:

- Female athletes with a birth sex of female
- Open athletes with a birth sex of male, trans or non-binary competitors and any competitor not eligible for the female category

The policy refers only to Swim England competition (including those organised by our member Regions, Counties, Clubs and affiliated organisations) and will be implemented on 1 September 2023.
