Key areas of Concern

This quarter we noticed a few reoccurring trends of concern that may prevent not only SwimMark accreditation but also Swim England Club Affiliation:

Sessions being run without a level 2 Coach on poolside.

As per the Swim England Coaching Policy:

For club coaching and training sessions, Swim England expects that at all sessions there is at least one active Coach / Level 2 equivalent as a **minimum** on poolside who is responsible for the activities taking place.

• DBS and/or Safeguarding missing, expired or not fit for role.

Please be mindful that as per <u>WavePower</u>, all persons aged 16 or over in relevant roles require a DBS check, and all persons aged 18 and over in relevant roles require <u>Safeguarding training</u>.

We advise clubs to check their personnel reports on a <u>monthly</u> basis to ensure their are no missing or lapsed DBS checks or safeguarding training.

AGMs not being run in accordance with club constitution

A reminder to clubs to please consult their club constitution to ensure your AGM is run correctly. Some common issues we noticed were:

- -Clubs not electing the correct number of committee members
- -Clubs not sharing the independent examiner's report on the accounts
- -Clubs not electing or confirming their independent examiner
- -Elections not being made in line with constitutional procedure i.e. proposed and seconded
