In line with Wavepower and ensuring all bursaries are granted in line with the minimum standards given within this clubs should be aware of the following changes or reminders of previous requirements:

- The submitting club has no outstanding DBS or safeguarding issues on their Club Personnel Report
- The member appears on the club personnel report/coach & teacher register in an appropriate role for their qualification
- The application is completed within one month of the date given on the certificate*
- The member has not previously received Regional funding for the submitted qualification

*Please note due to the closed period until 30th June 2024 certificates dated from the 30th March 2024 onward will be considered subjected to all other requirements being met

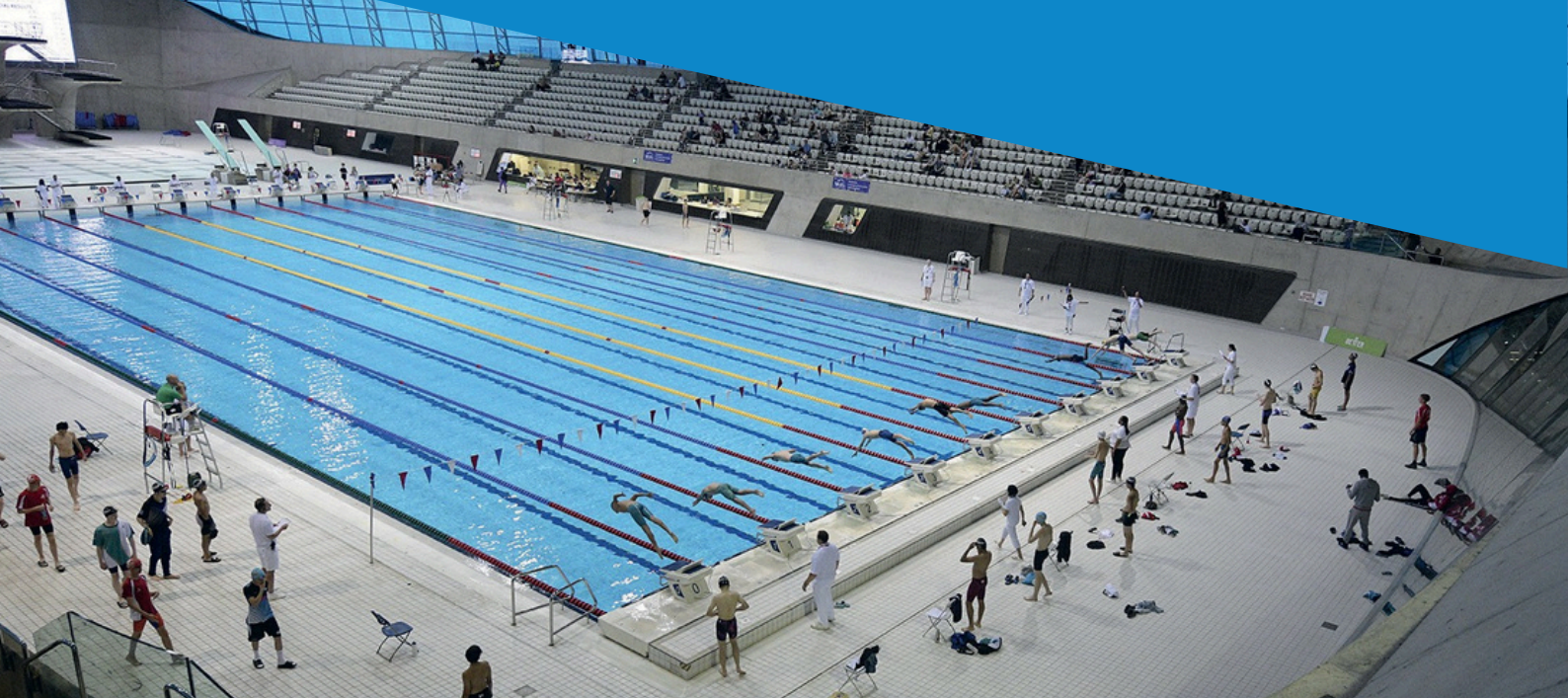

As a clarification/reminder: you must have gained your Swim England Safeguarding in Aquatics certificate within the last three years to complete this e-learning refresher. If your last safeguarding course was not the Swim England Safeguarding in Aquatics course, or if it was over 3 years ago, then you will need to attend the full Swim England Safeguarding in Aquatics 3 hour course.

Course booking reminder - 4 ways to save money!:

1. Ensure you use the [club offer booking process](#) - this heavily discounts the price:

Level 1 Coaching course reduced from £375 to £221.25 (41% discount)

Level 2 Coaching course reduced from £660 to £455.40 (31% discount)

2. If you are a SwimMark club then each year (in line with your reaccreditation date) you will have a £100 IoS voucher which can be used for courses or CPDs.

3. After the member has completed the course and received their certificate, the club can claim a [regional bursary](#) (criteria dependent) of £50 towards assistant coach courses, or £100 towards coach.

4. After the course is completed and certificated, look into the [county bursary funding](#) available.
